The Milken Institute School of Public Health, previously the School of Public Health and Health Services, was renamed to reflect significant contributions from the Milken Institute, the Sumner M. Redstone Charitable Foundation, and the Milken Family Foundation. These donations, totaling an unprecedented \$80 million, represent the most significant financial gift in the university's history.

Established in July 1997, the Milken Institute School of Public Health is the only public health school in the nation's capital. It welcomes a diverse student body, with more than 2,500 students from 48 U.S. states and territories and 32 countries who are engaged in public health programs ranging from undergraduate to doctoral levels.

The school, now ranked as the nation's #11 school of public health, is recognized for its commitment to advancing public health knowledge and training future leaders. Its emphasis on research and educational initiatives enables it to address the world's most pressing public health challenges.

Each student participating in the school's Graduation Celebration Ceremony is presented with a medallion. Undergraduates receive bronze medallions, graduate students silver medallions, and faculty members wear gold medallions.

Medallions, with a history dating back to ancient times, have long been emblematic of significant occasions and affiliations with various groups and societies. In the academic context, medallions are crafted in metal for ceremonial and commemorative purposes. Under the leadership of Dean Goldman, these medallions play a significant role in the school's traditions. Students are encouraged to wear them as part of their regalia for commencement on the National Mall and each time they wear them in the future - to symbolize their academic achievements and affiliation to the Milken Institute School of Public Health community.
